Session Description

Critical thinking is central to effective task management and decision-making in high-risk situations. This class reviews how actively assessing and analyzing information can help evaluate and improve the quality of thinking and discusses key principles of, and barriers to, thinking critically. The course also explains how to apply critical thinking throughout the nursing process to help staff arrive at the appropriate decision or conclusion.
