Critical thinking is vital in making effective decisions in health care, especially in urgent cases. In this course, you’ll learn how to evaluate and improve your quality of thinking by actively assessing and analyzing information.

You’ll study key principles of, and barriers to, critical thinking, along with how to apply it throughout the nursing process to help you and your staff reach the best decisions in each situation.

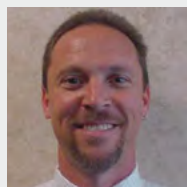
Following this course, you’ll be able to:
