Why a Local PAC Matters



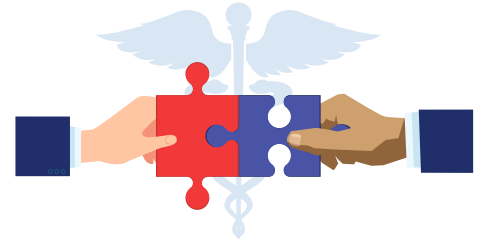
60% of state and federal elected officials start in local office.
