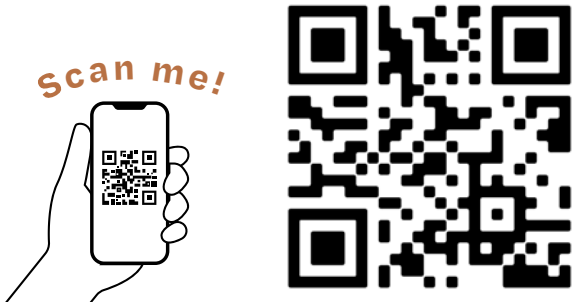


How to Nominate a Hero

HASC member hospitals may submit nominations based on your organization's unique mission and values. (Hospital systems may want to select a division representative to coordinate nominations among different locations.)

Hospital Heroes nominees should be team members who have stood out in positively

impacting patients and/or colleagues over the past 12 months. Staff from all areas are eligible: medical, clinical, administration, operations, volunteers, etc. The award committee will review all submissions and select the winners.

The following descriptions may help guide your process as you consider employees for nomination.

Unsung Hero

Diversity, Health Equity and Inclusion (DHEI) Champion

Staff whose unwavering commitment to diversity and inclusion inspires change. These

team members advocate for a positive difference, transforming the lives of patients and peers with their efforts to create a more just and balanced health care system.

Health Care Innovator

Employees who seek new, creative ways to help their hospitals better care for patients. They constantly strive to improve care delivery and patient outcomes, whether through better business practices, improved data access or innovative educational programs.

Community Impact

Team members who have significantly

impacted the health and safety of their community. With leadership and passion, they show commitment above and beyond their normal job duties and a clear desire to strengthen their hospital's social responsibility.

Excellence in Nursing

Nurses who consistently demonstrate compassion, skill, knowledge and excellence in caring for patients. These committed staff regularly brush up on and implement best practices to enhance quality of life and patient safety. They stand out as role models for the community.
