
On Sunday, December 1, 2024, PIH
Health experienced a criminal cyber
attack that impacted many applications
and communication systems throughout
our network, and severely disrupted our
hospital phone systems. During this
critical time, PIH Health Downey
Hospital, PIH Health Good Samaritan
Hospital and PIH Health Whittier
Hospital utilized the ReddiNet Satellite
Desktop VOIP (Voice Over IP) Phone
system, mandated by the Los Angeles
County EMS Agency through the
Hospital Preparedness Program grant
process.

The ReddiNet Satellite phone system became the primary point of contact for two of our three hospitals. Its reliability and seamless functionality proved to be a lifeline during this emergency, ensuring we could continue to communicate effectively despite the cyber attack, even when traditional communication channels were compromised.

Based on our experience, PIH Health is now in the process of expanding our use of the Satellite Desktop phones across all three of our hospitals. The reasonable cost and exceptional reliability of the ReddiNet Satellite system make it a crucial addition to our communication infrastructure, and we are confident in its ability to support our hospitals in future emergencies.





## **Satellite**

Even if internet, landlines and cell phones are down, satellite service will be available and air gapped from the hospital network.

Includes a dedicated, secure PC maintained and monitored 24x7.

24x7 Support, online monitoring, dispatch service and replacement.

## **VolP Satellite Phones**

Up to 5 satellite phones per location.

Phones can be placed anywhere on the hospital campus that a cable can reach. *No line of sight required.* 

You can call any phone number, just like a standard phone line, with unlimited domestic calling.

With 2 or more VoIP phones, you may communicate within your facility (such as EOC and DOC).

Voice checks available to validate consistent high-quality calls.
